This summer, we will be hosting summer camp at 12th Avenue for Preschool students.

Week 1: June 9-13 **Lazy Days of Summer**- Children will jump into summer fun by relaxing and reveling in camp activities. This week will be a transition into the “school’s out for summer” feeling and the elements of summer camp will be introduced.

Week 2: June 16-20 **Drama**- Come be in the spotlight this week. Learn theatrical terms, make costumes, and produce a play that will be presented for parents and friends.

Week 3: June 23-27 **Jewelry** - Boys and girls alike will enjoy working with metal and beads to create wearable art. Activities this week will also include creating a special box for their creations.

Week 4: June 30-July 3 (No camp on July 4th) **Around the World**
Children will go on “cultural adventures” and travel around the world, experiencing music, food, language and other cultural elements during this week.

Week 5: July 7-11 **Cooking**- Campers will have an opportunity to cook their own meals/snacks each day. They will learn kitchen and cooking safety, etiquette and hygiene.

Week 6: July 14-18 **Science and Photography**- This week offers opportunities to explore the world of photography and also act as young scientists. Activities will include experiments, engineering, and digital photography.

Week 7: July 21- July 25 **Music and Composers** - Do, Re, Mi, Fa, So, La, Te, Do. Come along on a magical, musical tour. Campers will explore musical instruments, styles, and composers during this week.

Week 8: July 28-August 1 **Art and Artists**- Campers’ creativity will flourish during this session. Children will experiment with different artistic mediums and study specific artists and their styles.

Week 9: August 4-8 **Gala**- Since this is the last week of the summer program, it will end with a student-run Gala, like our annual school Gala. Campers will get a chance to host their own party with an art show.

Camp will be from 8:00am-12:00 pm.

Extended care is available from 7:00am-5:30pm. Afternoons will include indoor sports and games, Wednesday “Film Studies and Italian Cuisine” (pizza and a movie), Thursday “Splash-a-thon”, Friday “Share Day”, and other enrichment activities.
